

Instructions for NEET PG- 2020 Uttarakhand State Centralized Counselling (FAPUS- Courses)

(In compliance to Uttarakhand GO 986/XXVIII-2/2014/01 (45)2014 dated 23 June, 2015)

Eligibility:

- a. All interested eligible candidates will have to register afresh by online mode only as per schedule to become eligible for FAPUS counseling.
- b. Candidates who will not register (online) will not be eligible and/or considered for FAPUS counseling.
- c. All the candidates who have qualified the NEET (P.G.) 2020 examination are eligible to participate in FAPUS counseling
- d. **Fundamentals of Abdomino-Pelvic Ultrasonography (FAPUS)—Level one for MBBS Doctors- 06 months course.**
 - Is an Indian citizen.
 - Has passed the M.B.B.S Examination from a Medical College, recognized by the MCI.
 - Must have fulfilled all eligibility criteria mentioned in the NEET PG-2020 brochure and qualified NEET PG-2020 examination.
 - Has completed compulsory rotatory internship training on or before 31.03.2020. No request for time relaxation in compulsory rotatory internship under any circumstances will be accepted.
 - Registration with M.C.I./State Medical Councils is compulsory and its documentary proof should be uploaded at the time of online counselling and submitted at the time of admission in allotted college. Candidate has to register himself/Herself to Uttarakhand State Medical council within 02 months of joining the PG course.

The FAPUS level I course of 06 months duration will be conducted in two batches (Batch -I from August 2020 to Jan. 2021 & Batch- II from Feb. 2021 to July 2021) in the following institutes:-

1. Procedure:

- a. FAPUS Counselling will be conducted by online mode only.
- b. All the candidates have to register for FAPUS counseling by payment of registration fees of Rs.2,000/-
- c. The Registration is to be paid by online mode only (NET-banking/ Debit card/ Credit card)

2. Security Fees:

Security fee not applicable for candidate's interested in FAPUS course only

However a candidate opting for both MD/MS and FAPUS will have to deposit the security fee as per rule

3. Document Upload:

Registered candidate have to upload their documents after depositing the required registration fee for FAPUS counseling.

OBC Candidates are advised to check his/her OBC certificate carefully and ensure that it is valid, because the OBC certificate is valid for three years duration only from date of issue. The OBC certificate should be valid on the date of admission for session 2020-21 that is 31.07.2020 or at the time of counselling and admission in the concerned college/Institute- Claim of candidates for reservation with invalid OBC certificate will be summarily rejected during the counselling and he/she will be considered as un-reserved candidate only.

4. Choice Filling:

Candidates must fill choices for FAPUS counseling of seat allotment as per Seat Matrix uploaded on the website.

5. Allotment:

Allotment on available State quota seats and All India-Management quota seats will be done by the Counselling Board purely on the basis of NEET PG-2020 State merit list of FAPUS counselling of the eligible candidates and choices filled by the candidates.

6. Admission:

The candidate have to secure the admission in the allotted college sending all required documents by email and by payment of entire course fee and other fee to college account by online method between **03-08-2020 to 10-08-2020**

7. Conversion of Seats:

If any State quota seats remain vacant due to non availability of interested eligible registered candidates of their respective categories, then these vacant seats will be converted as per existing rules. (Please read the information brochure for detail.)

8. General Conditions:

- (a) The Counselling Board/University will not be responsible for any mistake committed on the part of candidates during counseling process.

- (b) Candidate must fill application form carefully as once submitted application form cannot be changed/edited later under any circumstance
- (c) No request for extension of last date of admission will be entertained in view of guidelines of MCI / Hon'ble Supreme court.
- (d) All the rules and regulations are subject to change as per the directions of the Hon'ble Courts/ Govt. of India/MCI/Govt. of Uttarakhand guidelines.
- (e) Candidates are advised to visit the university website regularly for any updates.
