

Instructions for NEET PG- 2020 Uttarakhand State Mop-Up Round of Centralized Counselling (MS/MD/MDS Courses)

1. Eligibility:

- (a) All interested eligible candidates will have to register afresh by online mode only as per Mop-Up schedule to become eligible for Mop-Up Round counseling.
- (b) Candidates who will not register (online) will not be eligible for Mop-Up/Stray vacancy round.
- (c) All the candidates who have qualified the NEET (P.G.) 2020 examination are eligible to participate in the Mop-up round of counselling.

The following category of candidates are not permitted to participate in Mop-Up round:

- Candidates who are already admitted to MS/MD/MDS course through Ist & IInd Round of NEET PG-2020 Uttarakhand State Centralized Counseling **are not eligible to apply for Mop-Up round.**
- The candidates who have taken admission and retained their seats in various colleges in India under All India Government quota seats/Deemed Universities after second round of All India Counselling will **not be eligible** for Mop-Up round as per the Govt. of India/MOH&FW/Hon'ble Supreme court (writ petition civil no. 267/2017 dated 09/05/2017 direction no.4 and MCC).

2. Procedure:

- (a) Mop-up round will be conducted by online mode only.
- (b) All the candidates (including those registered for round I & II) have to register for mop-up round of counselling by payment of registration fees of Rs. 2,000/-
- (c) The Registration is to be paid by online mode only (NET-banking/ Debit card/ Credit card)

3. Security Fees:

- (a) All the new candidates have to deposit the security deposit as per information uploaded on university website as separate link.
- (b) Candidates who have already deposited security amount in previous round and if deposited security amount was not forfeited, need not to be deposit security fee again.
- (c) Already registered candidates (but not admitted) who wish to change the choice of college (Private/Govt.) can do so by selecting the following option:-
 1. The Candidates who participated in round I &/or round II and opted for Govt. colleges only by paying the required security fee but now want to opt for private college also will have to again deposit the security fee of Rs. 2,00,000/-(the security deposit paid in round I&/or round II will be refunded separately).
 2. The Candidates who participated in round I&/or round II and opted for Private and/or Govt. colleges both by paying the required security fee of Rs. 2,00,000.00 but now want to opt for Government colleges only are not required to deposit the security fee again (the balance security fee paid in round I&/or round II will be refunded separately).

(d) The Security fee (by new candidates and by those whose security is forfeited) is to be paid by any one of the method

1) Online mode only (NET-banking/ Debit card/ Credit card)

Or

**2) Direct credit to University account by NET-banking/RTGS/NEFT

Candidate opting the option -2 must ensure that after direct transfer of the money latest by 01:00 PM on 27-07-2020 they must send the receipt received from bank with UTR/ Transaction detail to NEET email ID ukneetcounselling@gmail.com immediately

3. Document Upload:

- (a) Already registered candidates need not to upload their documents again, but they must fill their online choices for MOP UP round after depositing the required registration fee for MOP UP round.
- (b) After depositing the required registration & security fee candidate have to upload their required documents and filled their choices for Mop-Up round. These choices are only valid for MOP UP round.
- (c) The candidate who has uploaded his/her documents in the previous round of counselling are hereby advised to check their category/sub category certificates/ documents again for validity as only the valid original documents will be accepted during Mop-Up round.
- (d) OBC Candidates are advised to check his/her OBC certificate carefully and ensure that it is valid, because the OBC certificate is valid for three years duration only from date of issue. The OBC certificate should be valid on the date of admission for session 2020-21 that is 31.07.2020 or at the time of counselling and admission in the concerned college/Institute- Claim of candidates for reservation with invalid OBC certificate will be summarily rejected during the counselling and he/she will be considered as un-reserved candidate only.

4. Choice Filling:

Candidates must fill fresh choices for Mop-Up round of seat allotment as per Seat Matrix uploaded on the website. Choices of round I & II will not be considered for seat allotment.

Candidate must fill choice carefully as once submitted choice cannot be changed/edited later under any circumstance.

These choices are only valid for MOP UP round.

5. Allotment:

Allotment on available State quota seats and All India-Management quota seats will be done by the Counselling Board purely on the basis of NEET PG-2020 State merit list of Mop Up round of the eligible candidates and choices filled by the candidates.

6. Admission:

- (a) The candidate have to secure the admission in the allotted college sending all required documents by email and by payment of entire course fee and other fee to college account by online method on or before **29-07-2020**.
- (b) The candidate has to report in person at the allotted college latest by **30-07-2020 by 01.00 PM** for confirmation of admission. In case of non-reporting by the candidate his or her allotment will be cancelled and seat will be deemed vacant for college round allotment (stray vacancy round).
- (c) Keeping in view the last date of admission fixed by Hon'ble Supreme Court/MCI as 31st July 2020 candidates are advised to strictly follow the time line and make necessary arrangement for travel. No extension of time will be given to the candidate.
- (d) It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to contact and collect all the information beforehand regarding various admission formalities of the concerned college of their choice.

7. Conversion of Seats:

Seat available for allotment in mop –up round will be offered to candidate of same category.

If any State quota seats remain vacant due to non availability of interested eligible registered candidates of their respective categories, then these vacant seats will be converted as per existing rules during Mop-Up round seat allotment process. (Please read the information brochure fordetail.)

In private colleges/University, If the candidates are not available for state quota seat, the said seat will be offered to candidates eligible under management quota.

8. “Stray vacancy round - Admission at college level”:

As per the direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court the Waiting list of candidates in the ratio of 1:10 will be forwarded to the colleges for Stray vacancy round - Admission at college level.

The waiting list will be prepared from candidate registered for Mop-Up only

No new registration will be permitted for stray vacancy round and the candidate whose name is not in waiting list provided by the University will be considered for admission in any case.

The admission will be made by the concerned college keeping in view the merit of the candidate in view of directions and time schedule given by **Hon'ble Supreme Court. It is the duty of the institute to ensure the transparency of the entire admission process of stray vacancy round.**

The candidates who have secured admission in any seat in First, Second and Mop-Up round of counselling will not be eligible for “Stray vacancy round - admission at college level” through waiting list for any stray vacancy, to be held on as per schedule by the concerned college.

The candidate who will not secure the admission after allotment in the Mop-Up round there security fees will be forfeited. But their name will be considered in the waiting list for Stray vacancy round - Admission at college level.

9. General Conditions:

- (a) The Counselling Board/University will not be responsible for any mistake committed on the part of candidates during counselling process.
- (b) Candidate must fill application form carefully as once submitted application form cannot be changed/edited later under any circumstance
- (c) No request for extension of last date of admission will be entertained in view of guidelines of MCI / Hon’ble Supreme court.
- (d) All the rules and regulations are subject to change as per the directions of the Hon’ble Courts/ Govt. of India/MCI/DCI/Govt. of Uttarakhand guidelines.
- (e) Candidates are advised to visit the university website regularly for any updates.
