

Instructions for NEET PG- 2020 Uttarakhand State

Extended Stray Vacancy Round of Centralized Counselling **(MS/MD/MDS Courses)**

1. Eligibility:

- (a) All interested eligible candidates will have to register afresh by online mode only as per extended stray vacancy round schedule to become eligible for extended stray vacancy round counseling.
- (b) Candidates who will not register (online) will not be eligible for extended stray vacancy round.
- (c) All the candidates who have qualified the NEET (P.G.) 2020 NEET MDS 2020 examination are eligible to participate in the extended stray vacancy round of counselling.
- (d) The candidates must refer the Information bulletin of NEET PG-2020 Uttarakhand State Centralized Counseling for detailed eligibility criteria.

The following category of candidates are not permitted to participate in extended stray vacancy round:

- Candidates who are already admitted to MS/MD/MDS course through Ist, IInd, Mop-Up & Stray vacancy round of NEET PG-2020 Uttarakhand State Centralized Counseling **are not eligible to apply for** extended stray vacancy round.
- The candidates who have taken admission and retained their seats in various colleges in India under All India Government quota seats/Deemed Universities after second round of All India Counselling will **not be eligible** for extended stray vacancy round as per the Govt. of India/MOH&FW/Hon'ble Supreme court (writ petition civil no. 267/2017 dated 09/05/2017 direction no.4 and MCC).

2. Procedure:

- (a) Registration for extended stray vacancy round will be conducted by online mode only.
- (b) All the candidates (including those registered for round Ist, IInd, Mop-Up & Stray vacancy round) have to register again for extended stray vacancy round of counselling by payment of registration fees of Rs. 2,000/-
- (c) The Registration fee is to be paid by online mode only (NET-banking/ Debit card/ Credit card)

3. **Security Fees:** No security fee is to be submitted for this round of counseling.

4. Document Upload:

After depositing the required registration fee candidate have to fill the online application form and upload their required documents.

However already registered candidates need not to upload their documents again, but they **must** register themselves after depositing the required registration fee for extended stray vacancy round.

5. Choice Filling & Allotment:

No Choice Filling or Fresh Allotment will be carried out for the Extended Stray vacancy round of counseling by NEET PG 2020 Uttarakhand State centralized counseling board.

The waiting list of eligible candidates (Registered for extended Stray vacancy round only) will be forwarded to the concerned Medical/Dental Colleges against the vacancies available. The Candidates can directly report to the institute for allotment to be made as per merit.

6. Waiting List & Admission:

- As per the direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court the Waiting list of candidates in the ratio of 1:10 will be forwarded to the colleges for extended Stray vacancy round - Admission at college level.
- The waiting list will be prepared from candidate registered for extended stray vacancy round only.
- Candidate whose name is not in the waiting list provided by the University will **not** be considered for admission in any case.
- The detailed admission procedures including reporting dates will be notified by the concerned Medical/dental colleges at their official website.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to contact and collect all the information beforehand regarding various admission formalities of the concerned college of their choice.
- The admission will be made by the concerned college keeping in view the merit of the candidate in view of directions and time schedule given by **Hon'ble Supreme Court. It is the duty of the institute to ensure the transparency of the entire admission process of stray vacancy round.**

7. Conversion of Seats:

In private Medical/Dental colleges/ Private Universities, if the candidates are not available for state quota seat, the said seat will be offered to candidates eligible under management quota.

(In Government Medical colleges the available state quota seats may be offered to All India candidates if No eligible candidate is available for admission, subject to receiving of approval by the State Government in view of the recommendations submitted by the boards. The same will be notified separately through the university website.)

8. General Conditions:

- (a) The Counseling Board/University will not be responsible for any mistake committed on the part of candidates during counseling process.
- (b) Candidate must fill application form carefully as once submitted application form cannot be changed/edited later under any circumstance
- (c) No request for extension of last date of admission will be entertained in view of guidelines of MCI / Hon'ble Supreme court.
- (d) All the rules and regulations are subject to change as per the directions of the Hon'ble Courts/ Govt. of India/MCI/DCI/Govt. of Uttarakhand guidelines.
- (e) Candidates are advised to visit the university website regularly for any updates.
